### **Roles and Responsibilities.**

1. To promote diversity and inclusive practices on the campus & provide the disadvantaged groups with adequate opportunities.
2. To raise awareness regarding issues amongst the stakeholders & help to create an enabling & non discriminative environment for the disadvantaged groups in the institution of higher education.
3. To ensure implementation of policies, schemes and programmes for the inclusion of underprivileged groups within the framework of policies and guidelines of the GOI/UGC
4. Focusing on overall personality and skill development so as to ensure enhancing the student's employability.
5. Inclusive growth for everyone by encompassing everyone into the mainstream of society.
6. Providing personal counselling and career guidance.
7. Awareness building and sensitization regarding discrimination on various grounds.
8. To disseminate the information related to schemes and programmes for the welfare of the socially weaker section as well as notifications/memoranda, office orders of the Government, or other related agencies/organizations issued from time to time.
9. To prepare barrier free formalities/procedures for admission/ registration of students belonging to the disadvantaged groups of society.
10. To establish coordination with the Government and other agencies/organizations to mobilize academic and financial resources to provide assistance to students of the disadvantaged groups.
11. To organize periodic meetings to monitor the progress of different schemes.

12. To adopt measures to ensure due share of utilization by SC/ST in admissions, Recruitments (teaching and non-teaching posts) and to improve their performances.

13. To sensitize the college on the problems of SC/ST and other disadvantaged groups.
